

## Two Come To Block-Long Blows Over Drugs

On Friday, October 20, in an incident that ranged along Steinway Street from 34th Ave to Broadway, a 26-year-old Hispanic male was charged with assault, criminal possession of marijuana and unlawful possession of marijuana after a 32-year-old Hispanic male stated the perpetrator had punched the him in the face and was hiding drugs in a vehicle. The 32-year-old Hispanic male was charged with assault after he punched the 26-year-old Hispanic male in the face.
