

# Local Man Stabbed In Astoria Park

Police of the 114th Precinct are seeking Miguel Rivera, aka Todd Rivera or Mike Rivera. Rivera, 25 years old, approximately 5 feet, 7 inches tall, weighing 170 pounds, with black or dark brown hair tied in a ponytail, is wanted for questioning in the stabbing death of Emrand Hossain, 19, who was found at about 2 a.m. last Wednesday, May 16, at the edge of Astoria Park at 28th Street and Hoyt Avenue, stabbed once in the chest. Hossain, of 30-86 32nd St., was taken to Elmhurst Hospital Center and pronounced dead two hours and 15 minutes later.

## 114th Police Precinct Blotter Highlights

### Sunday, May 20:
