

114th Police Pct. Blotter Highlights

Sunday, March 23:

• A 73-year-old Hispanic male in a car accident at Broadway and 30th Street was charged with aggravated unlicensed operator and unlicensed operator after he was found to be operating a vehicle with a suspended license.

• A 17-year-old black male was charged with robbery after he forcibly took a victim's cellphone at 38th Street and 34th Avenue.

• A 20-year-old Hispanic male was charged with criminal possession of marijuana after he was observed smoking marijuana in public at 42-02 Northern Blvd.
